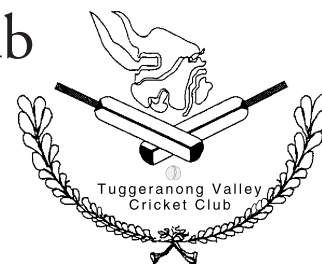

In2Cricket (Have-A-Go and Have-A-Game) registration will also be available at these times.

Season registration fees which include player insurance and GST are as follows:

1. Single Junior \$85.00
2. Two Juniors \$135.00 and \$30.00 for each additional Junior player from the family
3. In2Cricket (Have-A-Go and Have-A-Game) registration \$60.00 (no discounts).
4. Girls Cricket - Tuggeranong welcomes girls in In2Cricket and Junior teams.

ACT Cricket will also conduct cricket for girls teams - Contact Anna Baker on 6239 6002.

**NOTE: Credit card and Debit card payment will be accepted. There is no EFTPOS facility.**

**Age eligibility applies at 1 September 2010.** e.g. If a player turns ten on 31 August 2010 or earlier, they will play U11s. If a player turns ten on 1 September 2010 or later, they will play U10s.

New players must produce their Birth Certificate or Birth Extract at registration.

THE CLUB PROVIDES ALL EQUIPMENT, BUT RELIES UPON PARENTAL SUPPORT FOR COACHING, MANAGING, UMPIRING AND SCORING. ALL ASSISTANCE WILL BE GRATEFULLY APPRECIATED.

HARDSHIP CASES WILL BE CONSIDERED ON MERIT AFTER WRITTEN APPLICATION TO THE COMMITTEE.

Dear Players, Parents and Guardians

Welcome to the 2010/11 season.

This season T20 matches will be introduced to the competition for U12 to U18s, with teams playing six matches throughout the season. Division 1 teams will play their T20 matches midweek, to retain the weekend structure of two day matches.

The coaching group from the senior section of the club will continue and expand the program to assist juniors and we look forward to their support in continuing to improve skills and assist the transition to senior cricket.

As an affiliate sporting club to the Vikings Club, we continue to receive funding and other benefits, and also have the continuing generous support of major sponsor The Good Guys Tuggeranong, and 5 Star Plus Cricket Equipment ACT. These sponsors have ensured the continuation of our modest fee structure, and will enable the juniors to fund coaching support and courses where required. Except for the addition of T20 midweek, the playing times have stayed the same for the age groups. The combination of Under 16 Div 1 and U18 Div 1 last season to make the Colts a strong competition proved successful and will be continued.

The club continues to value the contribution made by the parent volunteers that are the coaches and officials of each team, encourages those that supported the junior players in 2009/10 to continue this season and welcomes support from new members. The ACTCA again require volunteers with direct unsupervised contact with players to complete a Member Protection Declaration form.

This season, to increase our funding base slightly and simplify payments, the early discount will not apply and the single registration fee will be \$85, and the family fee \$135. This is the first rise in fees for many years.

## **UNDER 9s**

Under 9 teams are not graded for skill levels. Many players in Under 9 come from In2Cricket and can nominate to play with teammates from In2Cricket, or school friends. Except for these special requests, teams are based on area where possible. Players will be contacted by their coach to advise where training will be held. Do not be concerned if this does not happen until close to the start of the season.

## **UNDER 10s**

These teams are also not graded for skills levels. Where possible, players will be kept in teams from last season, but new players can nominate to play with teammates from In2Cricket, or school friends. Under 10 teams are based on area where possible. Players will be contacted by their coach to advise where training will be held. Do not be concerned if this does not happen until close to the start of the season.

## **UNDER 11s**

There will be grading for Under 11 players, with a team playing in a Canberra-wide Division 1 competition. The remaining teams will play in a local area competition. Under 11 players are requested to try out at the grading which will be held on Monday 30 August 2010 (see below).

Batting helmets are not supplied in Under 11 team kits.

When all Under 11 to Under 18 Players have been graded, they will be allocated a coach and manager and informed where and when future practice sessions will occur, providing sufficient parent help is forthcoming. Please volunteer.
